WHEREAS, since 1973, the Motorcycle Safety Foundation has been working to improve cooperation between motorists and motorcyclists; and

WHEREAS, the Motorcycle Safety Foundation and the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration cooperatively support motorcycle rider education, high-quality licensing programs, and the promotion of safe and responsible riding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby proclaims May, 2011, as **Motorcycle Safety Month** in Hernando County.

SECTION 2. The Board of County Commissioners urges its citizens to take note of the increase in motorcycle traffic to enable the reduction in the number of accidents and injuries involving motorcyclists.

SECTION 3. The Board of County Commissioners supports increased public awareness of safely sharing the road with motorcyclists and promotes safe motorcycle riding skills.






